**Strategy 3**

Partner with member institutions and create a repository to identify third party products, services and software used by schools

**Strategic Goal 3**

Develop leaders to position themselves to participate on the GASFAA Executive Board

**Objective**

Inspire members to invest their talents and skills within the various GASFAA communities

**Strategy 1**

Highlight each Chair's purpose, benefits and level of commitment to the committee
